2007-2008 Program Description

Preschool

The District Preschool is a component of El Segundo Unified School District. State standards require that today's kindergarten classrooms be academically challenging. The District Preschool gives students a solid foundation of the social/emotional skills, physical/motor skills and cognitive/thinking skills needed to enter kindergarten confidently. The curriculum allows children to develop at their own pace through creative lesson planning that maximizes each child's unique strengths and interests.

- Meaningful classroom activities that challenge children to move forward. At the same time, children are able to successfully complete many of the tasks encountered so that they gain self-confidence, feel proud of their accomplishments, and learn to love learning.
- Curriculum that engages the children. The classroom has been arranged to give children easy access to toys and other materials. Children have the space to interact with their peers and adults.
- Literacy, math, and social studies centers.
- Balanced indoor and outdoor activities.
- Learning everyday through singing, dancing, discovery, play, and exploration.
- Staff members who set clear limits about acceptable social behavior, but understand that 3- to 4-year olds may be easily frustrated and are not always able to express their feelings verbally.
- A community of parents working with the preschool to enrich each child's individual experience.

Staffing

- Our experienced instructors hold a Child Development Permit.
- Two instructional assistants are present during instructional time to maximize individual learning.

Schedule

- The Preschool offers a program for 3 Year Olds and a program for 4 Year Olds. The program is tailored to meet the unique developmental needs of each age group.

Tuition

Families have the option of sending their preschooler two, three, or five days a week. 10% discount on 2nd Child.
